

Guidelines for your e-poster presentation

E-posters are **digital**, that means that are PowerPoint files, and **not printed Posters**.

You should prepare your presentation right after it is approved in a “PowerPoint presentation”, writing the text **ONLY** in **ENGLISH**, and **in two slides**: the first one will include the title, the authors, the affiliation, the purpose and the method. The second one will include the results, the conclusions and the bibliography.

After completing your e-poster, you should e-mail the file: agioftsi@phyed.duth.gr at least until **25 October 2020**. Attention: “save” your file by naming it using the Number of the Poster (e.g. P01) AND NOT THE TITLE of the abstract.

For your facilitation “download” the e-poster template and create your presentation by following the template, retaining the rest of the characteristics (background colour & logos).

Please note that your participation in the Conference and the presentation of your digital poster presentation will be certified by the electronic proceedings of the Conference which will be posted on the website after the end of the congress.

In case that none of the authors of the abstract is present during the date and time of the inclusion of the main topic, on which an abstract is presented according to the programme, the abstract will not be included in the Conference proceedings.

In order to find out the exact day and time of presentation of your digital poster, we are sending you the printout of the program.
